






Register at flydrone.no and take the online course and exam (not required if the drone is CE-marked as a toy or if it weighs below 250 g and does not have a camera).



Other distance limitations may apply if you pass the A2 exam and fly a drone between 500 g and 2 kg, or with a C2 class mark.

Are you under 16 years old? You can still fly in model clubs, together with a pilot 16 years or older, or with a CE-marked toy drone.

Fly safely and responsibly

- 1. Register and take the exam at flydrone.no.
- 2. Keep your drone in sight at all times.
- 3. Keep at least 5 km distance from airports and never fly near accident areas.
- 4. Always fly below 120 m from the ground and at a safe distance from others.
