Guidance for completing form NF-1139

One registration form is submitted for each candidate, prior to the first theoretical examination.

The candidate will be registered with all subjects for the relevant examination type.

According to FCL.025(a)(2), applicants shall only take the theoretical knowledge examination when recommended by the approved training organisation (ATO) responsible for their training, once they have completed the appropriate elements of the training course of theoretical knowledge instruction to a satisfactory standard.

Retake

It is not necessary to submit a new registration form for a retake. It is possible to sign up for re-examination after the quarantine period.

It is the candidates responsibility to ensure that he or she has received sufficient training before he or she re-examines.

Please note in the remarks section the theoretical background and from which year the exam was conducted. Theoretical background can be CPL(H) JAR-FCL amd. 1-3 etc.
